YELLOW FEVER VIRUS VACCINE STUDY

You may qualify for this study if you are:

✿ a healthy adult between 18-45 years of age ✿ not pregnant ✿
not already vaccinated with the yellow fever virus vaccine

The study will last approximately three months.

Study Volunteers will be eligible to receive the Yellow Fever vaccine along
with the International Certificate of immunization.

Study volunteers may also receive the vaccine at their doctor's office and
present for post-vaccination blood draws at the Hope clinic

You will be compensated \$50 for each of the 4 study visits.

The yellow fever vaccine has been FDA-approved and used to
vaccinate humans since the 1930s. The purpose of this study is to
characterize how the human immune system responds to vaccines.

We hope to use the information from this
study for the future development of better and safer vaccines.
